Enable Expands Residential Services



Enable is taking important steps to meet the critical shortage of residential services for people with disabilities:

- Two new group homes are scheduled to open in Brick Township this year
- Improvements are planned for four existing Enable homes
- A new home in Hamilton Township, Mercer County, is in the planning stages

Enable is also expanding the type of consumers it serves through residential services. Staff are being trained and skills developed to accommodate consumers with autism spectrum disorders, challenging sexually offending behaviors, and medically complex needs. On-site nursing care will be provided at some group homes as well.

"We are expanding our residential services as an answer to the call to provide programs for a diverse group of individuals with special needs," said Diana Kennedy, Chief Development Officer at Enable. "We pride ourselves on providing quality programs for those in need."

The State has approved funding for improvement projects at four existing group homes. Upgrades include adding bedrooms so that each resident has his/her own bedroom, constructing ramps, upgrading bathroom accessibility features, and adding sprinkler systems.
